





















Community Business Center Zoning




2225 Dutch Gold Dr, Lancaster, Pennsylvania, 17601 Rings: 1, 3, 5 mile radii

Currently, 56.0% of the 73,382 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 38.8%, renter occupied; and 5.3% are vacant.
